## OVERVIEW

A top-rated health care provider, Camino Medical Group (CMG) is one of northern California's largest physician-governed, multispecialty medical groups. CMG is a not-for-profit, community-based organization that contracts with most leading HMO and PPO insurance plans, and is a division of the Palo Alto Medical Foundation, which is an affiliate of Sutter Health.

Camino Medical Group has more than 220 primary care and specialty physicians, nurse practitioners and physician assistants.

## LOCATIONS

Camino Medical Group's 15 patient care sites are conveniently located throughout the South Bay in Sunnyvale, Mountain View, Santa Clara, Cupertino, San Jose and Los Altos.

## HISTORY

Camino Medical Group brings 52 years of dedication and medical expertise to the community. The group was founded in **1954** as the Sunnyvale Medical Clinic Inc. In **1994**, after years of progressive growth, the Sunnyvale Medical Clinic changed its name to the Camino Medical Group in conjunction with the development of an integrated delivery system with El Camino Hospital. In **1997**, Camino Medical Group was restructured as an independent entity, separate from the hospital. In **2000**, CMG joined the Palo Alto Medical Foundation, an affiliate of Sutter Health, to expand its range of services. CMG is structured as a community-based, not-for-profit organization focused on delivering the highest quality health care services, patient education and health care research.

## SERVICES

Camino Medical Group offers 32 medical subspecialties and a full range of services to meet the health needs of the community. The specialties include oncology, urgent care, general surgery, vision care, nutritional counseling, infusion therapy, travel medicine, sports medicine and much more. CMG physicians admit patients to El Camino Hospital.

## KEY STATISTICS

Camino Medical Group sees nearly 600,000 patients each year, covers nearly 170,000 patient lives, delivers more than 2,000 babies and performs more than 9,000 surgeries (both outpatient and inpatient at participating hospitals). The group is comprised of more than 220 physicians and more than 900 clerical and administrative support staff.

The annual operating budget is \$239 million. In addition, philanthropic contributions from our donors are made available for specific capital projects and operating initiatives.
